# MAN ON THE MOON: EXERCISE



## Step 1 : 5 mins

---

You are a member of a space crew originally scheduled to rendezvous with a mother ship on the lighted surface of the moon.

Due to mechanical difficulties, however, your ship was forced to land at a spot some 200 miles from the rendezvous point.

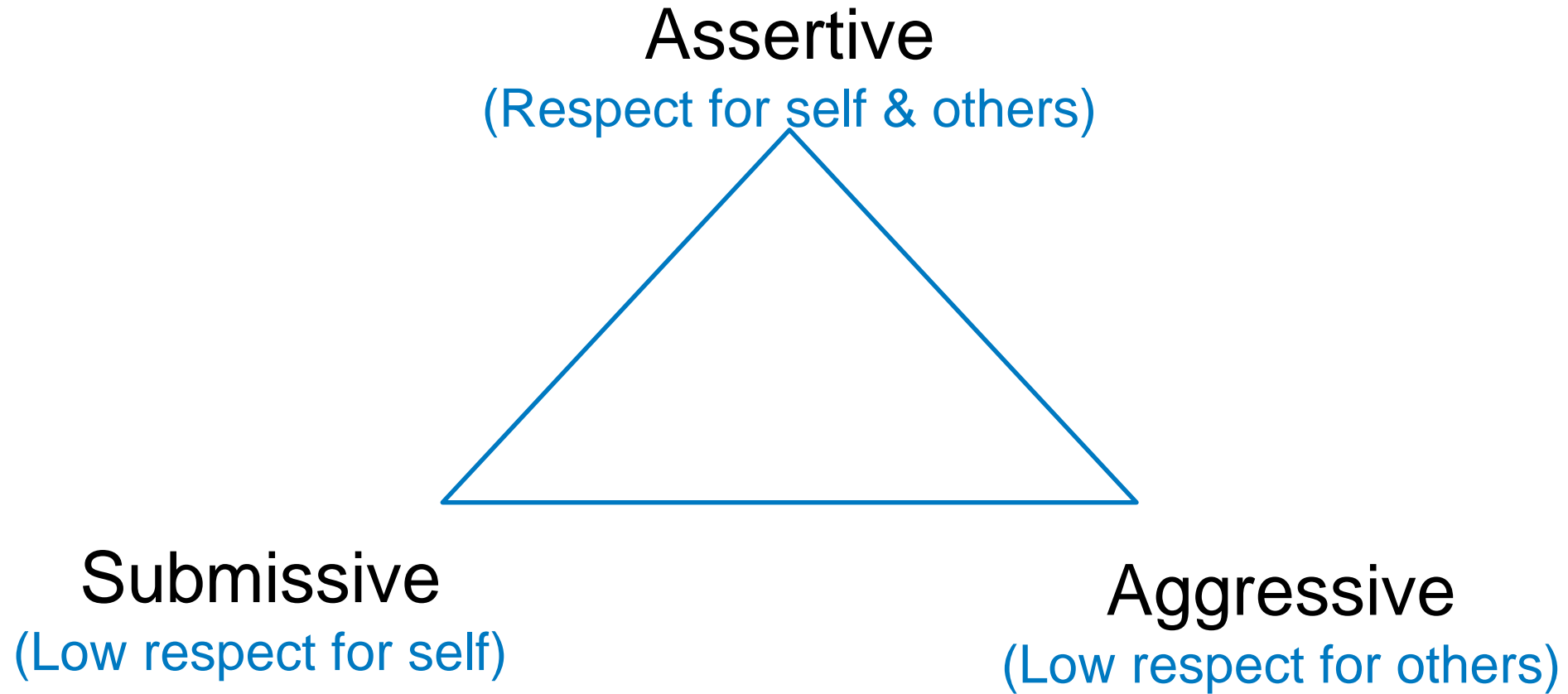

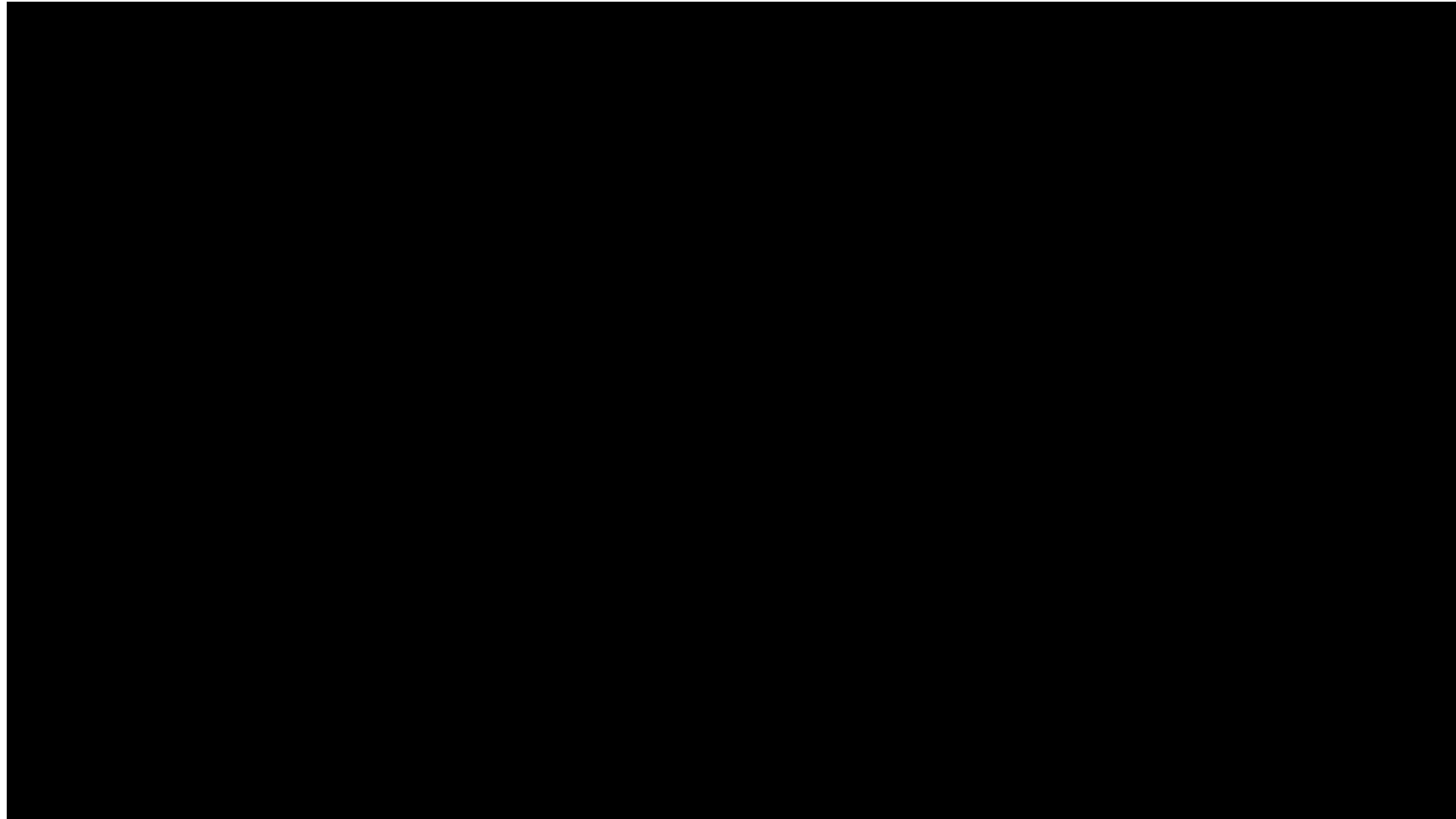
