How the Fund can help you

For over 20 years the Fund has been able to help a number of current and former members, their families and their dependants, during times of crisis and hardship by offering

- practical help during long periods of illness
- aids for temporary or permanent disability
- help during unemployment, including education or training fees.

If you want to apply for assistance, you must have been a member of IOSH for at least one year. Applications for payments from the Fund are treated in total confidence.

Gift Aid it (UK taxpayers only)

The Gift Aid scheme enables the IOSH Benevolent Fund to reclaim tax on every donation, providing that you complete a Gift Aid declaration and have paid UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax equal to the amount we reclaim. We recover 25p on every £1 that is given, at no extra cost to you. The information you give for this purpose will be kept confidential and will not be passed to any organisation other than HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC).
