Questions for the Speaker

Q - A member has completed their blueprint but could not upload it to their CPD.

A – The software does not allow this automatically. Go to your blueprint, scroll to the bottom, download to your desktop then copy back into your CPD record.

Q – Does a retired member have to do CPD ?

A – Only if they wish to retain their designation – CMIOSH or CFIOSH. Otherwise they lose their Chartered status.

Q – A member has watched hundreds of hours of safety videos and other learning during lockdown. Should they enter each session as an activity or just one activity for all the sessions.

A – Best to group them by type some several become one activity record.

Q – My CPD is not up to date, can I put in historic activities?

A – Yes you can backdate to 12 months.

Q – Can the order of the record of activities be changed so the most recent is at the top ?

A – Not at present the software doesn't work that way.

Q – Can IPD be also recorded as CPD?

A – Yes it's all professional development.

Q – What if I can't do any CPD at the moment eg due to redundancy?

A – Let IOSH know your circumstances and put an entry into your CPD plan indicating your problem.

Q – Can an activity not directly related to OSH be added to one's CPD such as learning a foreign language?

A – Yes if it could be of use as part of your work now or in the future.
