IOSH was pleased to be elected an ISO Category A Liaison body in January 2014 and we have provided two experts to contribute to PC 283 Work Group activity since. As a liaison organisation, IOSH contributes to the continual improvement of the management standards processes to develop international standards that ultimately provide benefits for business, government, and society.

IOSH’s contributors have played a key role in the development of ISO 45001 – the first internationally-agreed health and safety management systems standard to apply to organisations around the world. During the four years of development, IOSH provided thought leadership content in the form of masterclasses, articles, blogs, webinars, and briefings for members to keep them updated.

In October 2021, IOSH was proposed to jointly lead the Task group 1 Communications convenorship on an 18-month basis.
