

What happens once you pass your Open Assessment?

Once you have successfully completed the electronic open assessment there are just a few steps that IOSH has to undertake before you can book onto the interview.

These are:-

-  Step one Examiner informs IOSH that they have marked and passed your EOA
-  Step two Your result is confirmed subject to verification
-  Step three Request your CPD review by emailing cpd.enquiries@iosh.com
-  Step four If the CPD result is either Pass or Pass with recommendations, we will contact you advising of this and provide you with the available PRI dates
-  Step five You may now book onto the next available date
-  Step six Booking will be confirmed and details on the Presentation and Record of Employment (ROE) will be sent out
-  Step 7 At least four weeks before the interview date you need to send in your Presentation and ROE
-  Step 8 Two weeks before the interview date the Interview Administrator will contact you to discuss how the day runs and to provide advice
-  Step 9 Up to 21 days after the interview you will be informed of the result and if appropriate your transfer to Chartered status will be confirmed and certificate issued within two months. This is to allow our ratification process to take place.
